




## TOKEN OF LOSS



**Dr Benson Mulemi**, a medical anthropologist at the Catholic University of Eastern Africa, and visiting Fellow in the Centre of African Studies, will give a talk on stigma, spoilt identity and cancer rehabilitation in Kenya.
